

## Simple Crochet Plumeria

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Hook size: D

Yarn size: fingering

Options: This pattern will work with larger yarns. Use a hook size that will give you the look you want for the yarn you are using.

Basic notes: First you make the center loop, then you complete each petal one at a time. It's easy to add as many petals as you need for the look you want.

Center Loop: Ch 4 and join with slip stitch.

Petal:

R1: Ch 3 and join into center of Center Loop with slip stitch.

R2: Ch 3 [counts as first dc], dc 6 in R1. Turn.

R 3 – R4: Ch 3 [counts as first dc, dc in each stitch across petal. Turn.

R5 (Picot row): [Ch 3, sc in next stich] across top of petal. 6 picots.

Side row (This will curl one edge of your petal so that your flower has dimension.): sc in side of R4, sc in side of R3, sc in side of R2, sl to join in Center Loop.

Repeat for as many petals as you want.
